Wrap Carrier for Your Baby



Congratulations! We hear you had your baby. We encourage you to see your Obstetric (OB) Provider* and complete your postpartum visit between 21 to 56 days after delivery.

If you have **Blue Cross Community CentennialSM** and you have delivered, you can receive a wrap baby carrier from Blue Cross and Blue Shield of New Mexico (BCBSNM).**

To get the wrap carrier, you will need to:

- Enroll in the Special Beginnings[®] program.
- Visit your OB Provider for a postpartum visit between 21 to 56 days after delivery.
- Fax this completed form within 60 days of delivery to BCBSNM Health Services at **505-816-3854**. You or your OB Provider can fax this form. If you cannot fax the form or have questions, contact the Special Beginnings program at **1-888-421-7781 (TTY: 711)**.

**An OB provider is your maternity provider.

**Receipt of wrap baby carrier is a Value-Added Service through BCBSNM.
