The New Mexico Pharmaceutical Care Foundation received a \$25,000 grant to support participating community pharmacies that offer vaccines in collaboration with BCBSNM's Care Van<sup>®</sup> at community outreach events throughout the state. The grant allows pharmacies to offer additional vaccines — such as COVID-19, shingles, meningitis, tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis and many others - to help increase access to preventive care and fill gaps in missed vaccines for New Mexicans.

#### **SUSTAINABILITY**

<u>Care Van</u>

- Recycled nearly 214,000 pounds of paper
- 100% of the energy used in our buildings is offset by renewable energy credits

BCBSNM delivered \$20,000 in food to tribal communities in Whitehorse Lake, Torreon, Pueblo Pintado and Ojo Encino to help with food insecurity during the colder months, benefitting more than 1,000 families.
