This is important information on changes in your **Blue Cross Medicare Advantage (PPO)** coverage.

We previously sent you the Evidence of Coverage (EOC) which provides information about your coverage as an enrollee in our plan. This notice is to let you know that the law has changed and there are updates to your Medicare Part B prescription drug coverage. Below you will find information describing the updates. Effective July 1, your Part B insulin coinsurance cap is no more than \$35 for a one-month supply. Deductibles do not apply.
